Canadian Arctic

The Canadian Arctic is a vast region characterised by extensive areas covered in ice and snow for most of the year. This part of northern Canada, which is of immense ecological importance, has an extreme climate and a landscape dominated by the cryosphere (sea ice, glaciers, permafrost, snow and frozen ground), which has a significant impact on the flora, fauna and local communities.

The Great Lakes

The Great Lakes constitute one of the largest freshwater reserves on the planet. This interconnected system of five lakes – Superior, Michigan, Huron, Erie and Ontario – covers a vast area along the border between Canada and the United States. Their ecological and economic importance is incalculable, as they are vital for drinking water supplies, industry and transport.

The Rocky Mountains, stretching from New Mexico to Canada, form a majestic mountain range that shapes the landscape and ecology of North America. Their significance in Canada is immense, as they are home to biodiversity, vital water resources and a world-renowned tourist attraction, as well as being a cultural symbol.
