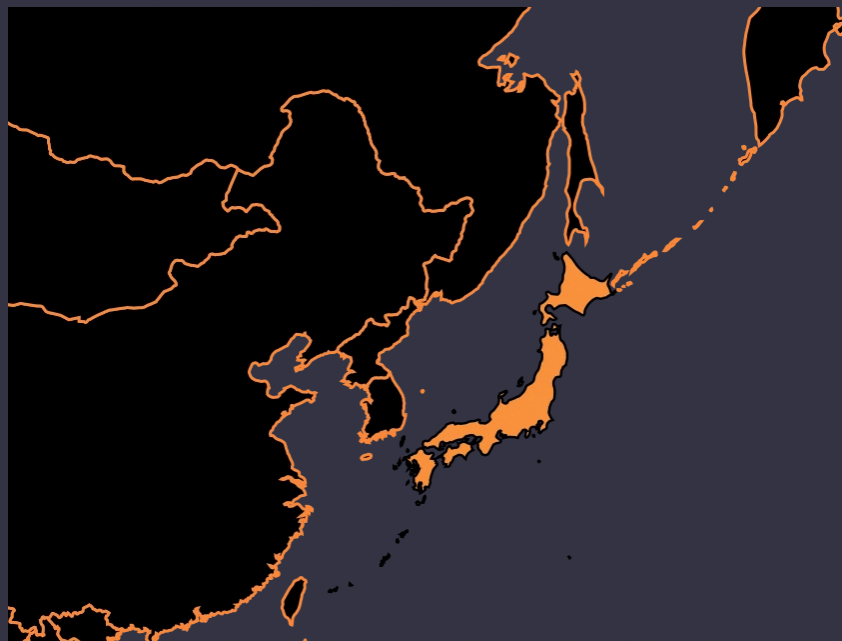
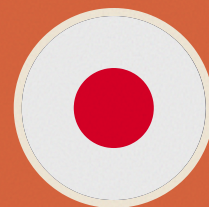

### Tokyo

### Osaka

### Nagoya

It is renowned for its impressive castle, art museum and science centre, as well as its rich culinary scene and nightlife.

### Tsu

274.879 pop.

# ● GEOGRAPHY OF JAPAN

## Archipelago

Japan is an island nation in East Asia, comprising a vast archipelago. Its main islands are Honshu, Hokkaido, Kyushu and Shikoku, but the country consists of more than 6,000 islands. Many of these islands are small, and some are uninhabited.

## Volcanoes

Japan has significant volcanic activity, with over 100 active volcanoes. Mount Fuji is the best known of these and serves as a national symbol. This intense seismic and volcanic activity is due to the country's location on the 'Pacific Ring of Fire', a geologically very active zone.

## Mountains

Japan is a predominantly mountainous country, with over 70% of its land area consisting of mountains. This feature limits the amount of flat land available, which has led to dense, high-rise urban development in many of its cities. The topography has a direct influence on the way communities settle and thrive in this environment.
