● PLACES TO EXPLORE

Buenos Aires

14.017.736 pop.

Buenos Aires is situated on the banks of the Río de la Plata and is one of the largest cities in Latin America. Its inhabitants are known as 'porteños' because, historically, many Europeans arrived in Buenos Aires via its port, having travelled by ship.

Córdoba

1.640.600 pop.

Córdoba is a melting pot of history and modernity. Known for its colonial architecture, such as the Jesuit Quarter, it also boasts vibrant cultural centres, parks and a lively nightlife.

Rosario

1.631.090 pop.

Rosario is a vibrant city on the banks of the River Paraná. The birthplace of the Argentine flag and home to Messi, it blends history with modernity. Explore the Flag Monument, stroll along the waterfront and enjoy its rich culture and cuisine

Ushuaia

82.298 pop.

Ushuaia is located in Tierra del Fuego and has a very interesting feature (which is why we've chosen it for this section): it is the southernmost city in the world. This means that no other city lies further south.

● GEOGRAPHY OF ARGENTINA

The Andes

The Argentine Andes form an imposing section of the mountain range, renowned for their snow-capped peaks and breathtaking landscapes. Aconcagua, its highest peak, is in fact the highest point on the American continent and the highest in the world outside Asia. Its diverse landscape includes glaciers, fertile valleys and high-altitude deserts.

The pampas

The Pampas, from the Quechua word for 'plain', is a vast expanse of flat land covering much of central Argentina, Uruguay and the southern tip of Brazil, stretching from the coast to the foothills of the Andes. Its two most striking features are the almost complete absence of trees and the large numbers of cattle.

Patagonia

Patagonia, a vast region located at the southern tip of South America (Argentina and Chile). Characterised by its breathtaking natural beauty, it encompasses the majestic Andes mountain range, vast steppes, ancient glaciers and a rich diversity of wildlife. It is defined by its cold climate and strong winds, and is home to unique flora and fauna adapted to extreme conditions.
